BAC Membership

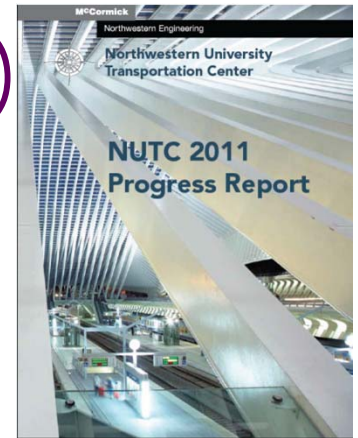
- **15** new companies, **15** new members

- Submitted: **19** proposals **\$5.71 M**, **10** faculty

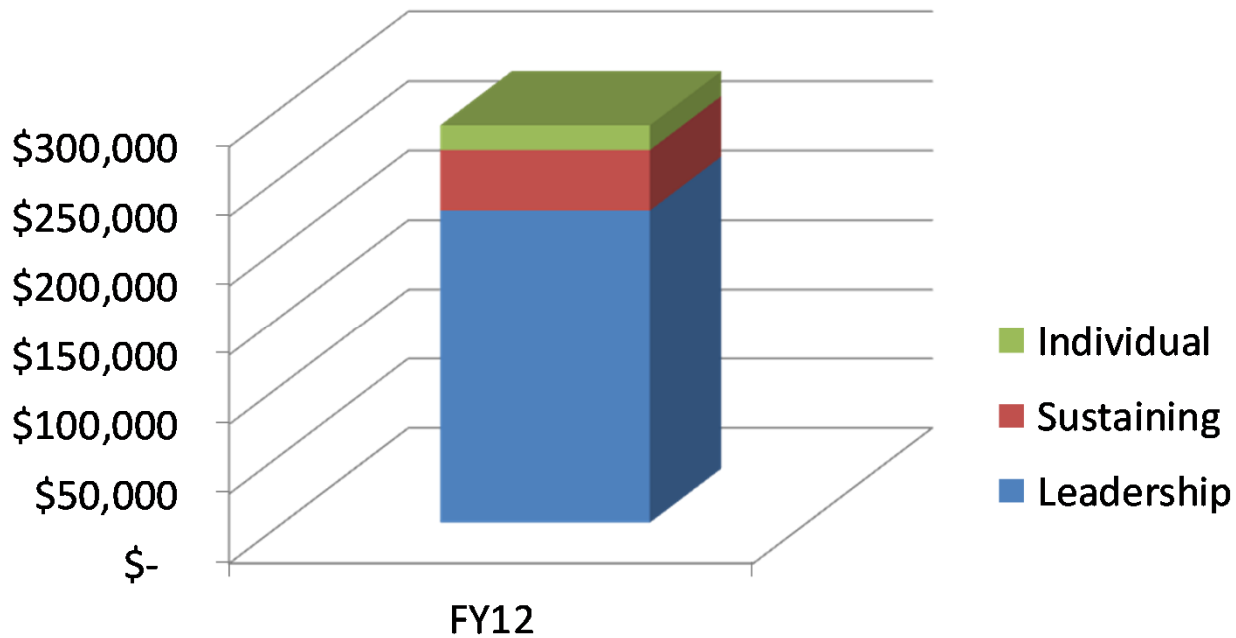
Graduate Students

- *Industry support is critical* to our mission and to making a Northwestern Education in Transportation the unique experience it is.

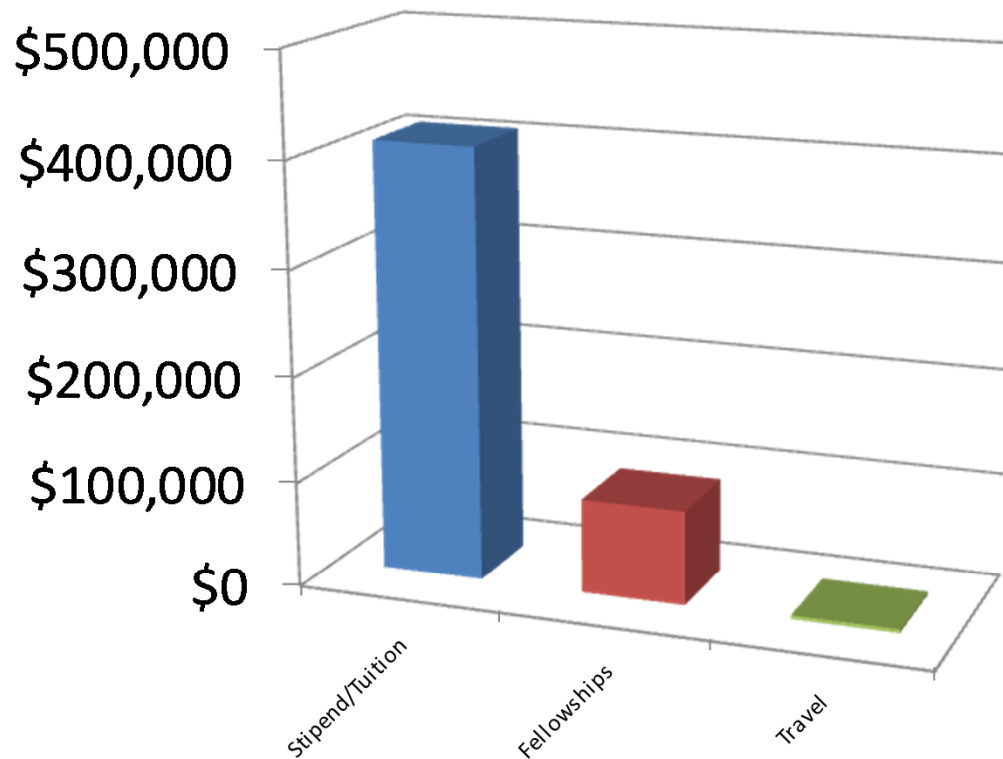

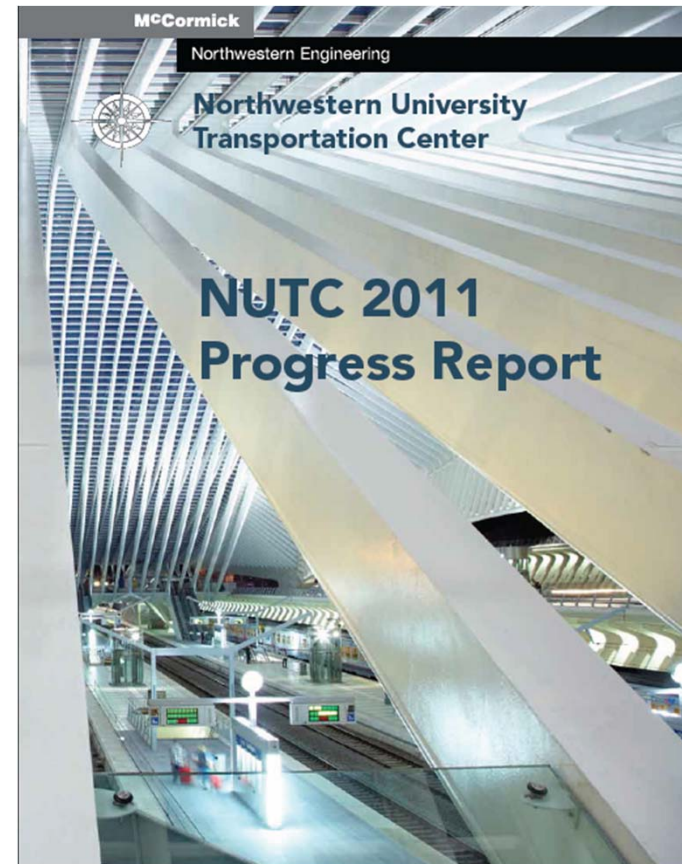
